Explanation of model: I chose “ella” because Srta. Monaghan is a girl and when I talk **about** her, I would use the subject pronoun “she”, which is “ella” in Spanish.

**** Note:** When I speak **to** Srta. Monaghan, I would call her an “usted” since she is someone with a title.
