Guía de estudio: Examen oral de capítulo 6B

For your Chapter 6B Oral Test on **Thursday March 30 and Friday, March 31, 2017** you will pick a random room out of a hat and describe some chores that you and your family members do in that room **en español** in **at least 4 sentences**. The prompt will look like the model below: (Except the underlined word in the model will change depending on what room you pick out of the hat!)

- ¿Cuál son los quehaceres que tú y tu familia tienen que hacer en la sala?

The following are the possible rooms you may pick from the hat:

- La sala
- El baño
- El comedor
- El despacho
- La cocina
- El dormitorio

Someone who wants to score in the **advanced** categories on the speaking rubric would do the following:

- Answer the question after hearing it once at normal speed.
- Answer all questions in complete sentences.
- Give an appropriate, descriptive, and thorough response. You are able to answer the question in depth. (in at least 6 descriptive sentences)
- Make few mistakes in vocabulary and grammar.
- Speak with a natural flow.
- Use current/past vocabulary in a creative and insightful way (Other examples include: Asking questions to the teacher while responding, turning the response into a conversation with the teacher)
- Include all elements of the 6B vocab. list in his/her response (uses different verbs/adjectives/nouns from our vocab. list, student shows they know how to use different conjugations of verbs.)

Here are some questions to help you think about what you can say to describe the chores that your family does in each room:

1. What chores do you do in each room?
2. What chores does your mom/dad/brother/sister/other family member do in each room?
3. When does everyone do the chores? Sometimes, every day, at night, on Saturdays, etc.?
4. Does anyone receive money for doing the chores?
5. Do you like to do these chores? Do you find them boring, fun, or interesting?
6. What household items does your family clean? The shelf, the nightstand, the table?
7. Which chores do you like more or less than other chores?
8. What is the best/worst chore to do in each room and why?
9. Does everyone in your family help with the chores or is there one person who isn't helpful?
