





- SARA: ¿Dónde vives?

- Where do you live?
I live in a house in Madrid.
- ADRIANA: ¿Dónde está el jardín?
ALVARO: El jardín está allá.
- Where is the garden?
The garden is over there.
- JOSÉ: ¿Dónde está el garaje?
FELIPE: Está detrás del jardín.
- Where's the garage?
It's behind the garden.
- CLAUDIA: ¿Cuántos cuartos hay en tu casa?
ESTELA: Hay cuatro cuartos.
- How many bedrooms are there in your house?
There are four rooms.




- There are four words for *the*: **el** (in front of a masculine singular noun), **los** (in front of a masculine plural noun), **la** (in front of a feminine singular noun) and **las** (in front of a feminine plural noun)
- The word **jardín** can mean yard, as well.
- Another word for bedroom is **la alcoba**.




